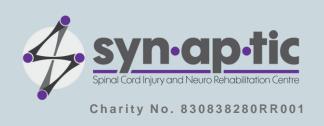

Breathe. Speak. Pace. THE COLLECTIVE NEED



A recovery path for people living with long term effects of Covid – 19 in the community.

A mandate to support people now facing complex health challenges.

A strategy to reduce the impact on our healthcare system



- Long Covid is a devastating consequence of Covid-19 (SARS -CoV2) infection.
- An estimated 10-30% of individuals infected will go on to have symptoms lasting greater than 12 weeks.
- Symptoms include fatigue, chest pain, shortness of breath and brain fog feature predominantly.
- Health care services for this population is currently limited and many are left without support from the medical community.
- Research is being conducted at higher levels; however, people need help now.

WHO

- Available to all Albertans with lingering symptoms of Covid 19 infection or suspected Covid19 infection (people sick in early spring 2020 have been denied a lot of coverage).
- 16 participants.
- 2 health care providers facilitating content delivery and break out rooms.

HOW \oplus



- Virtual 8-week education and selfmanagement program aimed at addressing Long Covid symptoms of fatique, breathlessness, dysautonomia, cough, hoarse voice, poor sleep and anxiety.
- Program also aims to act as a support group and a platform to participants to feel supported, believed and validated.
- Two one-hour sessions per week.
- Each participant undergoes a safety pre-screening with Physio Therapist prior to participating (15-20 min).
